## REGISTRATION for the 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

Registration of **SIBLINGS** for Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten will take place during the week of **January 30<sup>th</sup>**.

All pupils registering for the **first time** are required to provide the following documents:

- a birth certificate (long version) showing the names of both parents;
- a proof of Canadian citizenship for one of the parents;
- Medicare card;
- vaccination records;
- Eligibility Certificate of the child if available, otherwise the Certificate of Eligibility of an older brother/sister / natural parent, or the Québec Permanent Code (QPC) of the parent or sibling, who attended English school in Québec.

Registration for **NEW COMERS** for Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten will take place during the week of **February 6<sup>th</sup>**.
